Hymn History: "The Church's One Foundation" was written in 1866 by Reverend Samuel Stone in response to a heresy spreading through the Anglican church questioning the inerrancy of Scripture. Stone wrote a set of hymns titled *Lyra Fidelium*; Twelve Hymns on the Twelve Articles of the Apostles' Creed (1866). This hymn is included under the ninth article, The holy Catholic Church; The Communion of Saints. The controversy is alluded to in the third verse.

The text contains great teachings about Church doctrine. In the first verse, we see why the Church is of supreme importance. The second verse references The Great Commission (Matthew 28), which will have been accomplished when Christ returns (Revelation 5:9 and 7:9). True believers are united by one Lord, one faith, and one birth (Ephesians 4). This unity is expressed through the two ordinances given the church: baptism (Acts 22) and the Lord's Supper (“one holy food”; 1 Corinthians 11). Finally the last two verses affirms the peace we have rooted in Christ's return, and the mystic union existing between God, the Christian, and the saints throughout history. We rejoice in the promise of this rest, and pray we may grow in Christlikeness until we shall be united with Christ and his Body, singing the song of the redeemed for all eternity. The hymn is typically set to the tune "Aurelia" by Samuel Sebastian Wesley. He wrote the tune in 1864, and his wife named it 'Aurelia' ('aurum' is the Latin for gold).

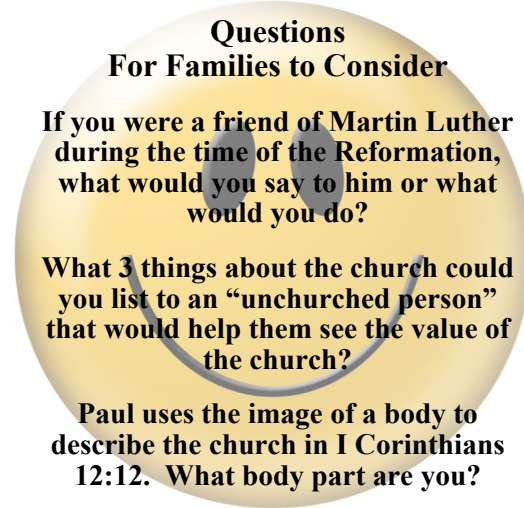
