Sunday Sermon Information |

Luke 22:14-23 | Rev. Dr. Ted Martin

This scene in the Bible is one of the most readily recounted pictures. Yet, it is only Luke who gives us the words that are etched into some Communion Tables. This sacrament that Jesus initiates and solemnizes during the “Last Supper” is one of the most important events in the life of the disciples.

Even as it is one of the most important events in our lives as disciples. It’s possible that Paul first penned the words, “Do this in remembrance of me” as he wrote to the Corinthian church about the sacrament of communion. Luke, being Paul’s companion and fully committed to capturing the best account of the life of Jesus, incorporated that phrase in his gospel. The proximity in time of both written pieces gives greater confirmation that these words were spoken by the gathered believers during the first century, and it has continued through the millennia. The significance of remembering cannot be underestimated in its value for us. This Sunday bathe in this powerful event in the life of first century disciples through to 21st century disciples.
