**Hymn Spotlight: *I Then Shall Live***

Gloria Gaither was inspired by Francis Schaeffer's 1976 book "How Should We Then Live?" and the many questions that book asked. How would Jesus ask us to live in the culture and community where we find ourselves? The answer to her was to live joyously as someone who has been forgiven. Her inspiration came as she was listening to a tone poem composed by the Finnish composer Jean Sibelius, "Finlandia." It was commissioned by a covert movement protesting Russian Empire censorship, so the complete work is full of music evoking the Finnish national struggle. Ultimately a calm and soothing melody is heard. Sibelius later rewrote that melodic phrase into the hymn tune we know today, as it is also used for the melody of "Be Still, My Soul."
